Premium Discount Program Remains Unchanged For 2008-09 Reporting Year

More than 6,000 Ohio employers have saved millions of dollars on their workers' compensation premiums with their safety council membership.

Active members of one of the 80 BWC sponsored safety councils will continue to receive a 2 percent participation discount on premiums, provided they meet the same elgibility requirements as 2007-08.

They need to attend 10 safety council meetings or BWC sponsored events, send a qualified senior-level manager to a safety council-sponsored meeting and submit semiannual workplace accident reports for the 2008 calendar year.

Also the same as last year, safety council members can work to receive a 2 percent performance bonus.

Employers who reduce their accident frequency or severity by 10 percent or more below the previous year's frequency or severity, or employers who maintain both frequency and severity at zero will qualify to receive the 2 percent performance refund.
