► Please submit your **first-half** (January 1 through June 30, 2008) semi-annual report as soon as possible.

In addition to attending 10 meetings (with the CEO or highest ranking official from your company or organization recording one of those 10 meetings) the semi-annual reports are one of the participation requirements to be eligible for the BWC rebate.

The second semi-annual report will run from July 1 through December 31, 2008 and these two reports are required to be eligible for the 2008-2009 rebate cycle (July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009.)

► Please remember to send in your annual Lake County Safety Council participation (membershp) fee by July 31, 2008.

For more than 20 years the LCSC has operated without membership dues/fees. In the last two years alone LCSC members earned more than \$1 million in workers' compensation rebates.

To remain eligible to participate in the LCSC remit the approprite amount as listed in the correspondence mailed to you.

If payment is not been received by the close of business on July 31, 2008, your company will be removed from elgibility for the 2008-2009 fiscal year.
