Performance Bonus Letter Distribution

Fiscal year 2008 (FY08) **performance bonus** and fiscal year 2009 (FY09) benchmark letters have been received by the Lake County Safety Council. The letters will be distributed at the December and January safety council meetings.

For the FY08 **performance bonus** letters **only** employers who met the FY08 eligibility requirements will receive the letter. For the FY09 benchmark letters, all employers eligible to pursue the current year's FY09 safety discount will receive the letter.

Employers who met the performance bonus criteria will receive the additional 2 percent (2%) check **mailed** to the primary mailing address listed with the BWC in mid-December, pending active BWC coverage and no outstanding balance to BWC.
