**LCSC Offering Two Special Training Sessions in October** 

The first program, õAccident Investigation Trainingö on Tuesday, October 6 from 8 to 11:30 a.m., will be held at the Lake County Department of Utilities Learning and Business Center.

Registration and pre-payment are required. The cost is \$250 for members and \$280 for non-members. Attendees will learn to conduct a thorough accident investigation, determine root causes of accidents, develop corrective actions and reduce accident rates and expenses.

The second technical training class offering that day, also at the Learning and Business Center, is from 1 to 4:30 p.m. That session will be õHazard Recognition.ö It discusses the top 100 OSHA standards violations, understanding why specific items are hazards and what potential injuries could occur. It will address how to remediate the hazard and avoid potential injuries and costly fines.

It is designed for safety director, safety committee members, management and maintenance. Registration and pre-payment are required. The cost is \$180 for members and \$230 for non-members.
